

Lyme Disease and Bartonella

The following pages contain three different test results of the C4a test on two different patients, a husband and wife.

Ken and Sue have been a patient of mine, (Dr Graham), for some time but only seen in my office a couple of times as they live in Eastern US. Both Ken and Sue have battled Lyme and Bartonella for many years, seeking the care of many alternative and orthodox physicians with mixed results. With over 90% of the US population exposed and over 80% of the population infected by Lyme and its co-infections, this is a very dangerous and common disease which can effect every patient differently. Many only feel minor chronic symptoms that are usually blamed on anyone of 300+ other conditions such as arthritis and so on. Many suffer from significant to severe life threatening conditions

and the disease is still commonly misdiagnosed as other conditions. Another major problem with a disease such as Lyme is that it compromises the immune system so completely that over time other disease processes often find the body a comfortable home. Usually they are sub-clinical or only mild, but they can activate and become a significant problem at the most inopportune times.

Fortunately, both Ken and Sue knew early on that their condition, which was quite severe, was from Lyme which prevented them from trying many other health threatening therapy procedures that would not have improved their health or condition and kept them focused on the correct therapeutic direction. Unfortunately, there are few, if any, consistent therapy programs that will actually correct Lyme disease and it's co-infections.

The C4a test is currently the most specific test for the activity of Lyme and its co-infections. As a test for very specific inflammation, it is not for just Lyme so many will say that it does not give a definite diagnosis for Lyme - which is true. But since the test **does** measure for Lyme inflammation, it can rule Lyme out. This means that, if the test is negative, the patient does not have Lyme or any of the co-infections of Lyme. And, if the test normalizes following a specific therapy program, it would indicate that the therapy improved or corrected the cause of that inflammation.

Fortunately in this case, we had the C4a lab results for a period of several months pre and post the BMR Therapy program. As you can see on 09/19/08 and the 01/12/09 test dates that both Ken and Sue have consistently had very high results on the C4a test. And, as stated in Ken's letter, they were treated in my office during the week of February 16th thru the 20th. Then approximately six weeks later

on 03/30/09 both Ken and Sue's test results were well within the normal limits. And, even more importantly, they felt good.

The treatment took proximately 1 week in our office utilizing the LazrPulsr Mk IV and the Body Memory Reset Therapy System program for Lyme. The results were spectacular and Ken now owns his own Mk IV laser and the BMR therapy system for other health care problems.

Even though Ken and Sue had impressive symptomatic results, we knew they were dealing with more than just Lyme and that other conditions would more than likely begin showing up. And as expected, within a few short weeks other latent infectious disease processes began to appear and give them trouble. Fortunately, since they had their own therapy system, they were able to address each of the other conditions as they came up on their own with just our guidance.

Both Ken and Sue are still enjoying significantly better health than before the original treatment and continue to improve and are great supporters of Natural Energy Medicine.
