I thought I should relate one of my first personal miracle experiences with the LazrPulsr. I had put off using some \"Indian salve\" or Black Salve for treatment of a squamous cell carcinoma just to the side of my right eye. With my new Mark I LazrPulsr to back me up, I decided to try it. I had never had personal experience with the salve. I applied the salve to a couple of lesions. (There was another one on my nose). It wasn't long before it became puffy, sore and red as it began drawing out the cancer. I applied the laser therapy twice daily for about 10 minutes each time. In a week, the cancer accumulation fell off, leaving a rather large deep hole. It was larger than a dime and smaller than a nickel. The thickness was about 3/16\" deep, down to the covering over the bone by the eye and almost all the way through my nose. I filled the holes with salve and continued lasering it for an additional week. In one week, the hole had completely filled in and a week after that the tissue had almost fully matured. The nose took longer than the eye and I gave up on it after 10 days by not putting anymore salve on it. The most amazing thing was that in spite of the depth of the lesion and the rather large size, the entire area filled with regular skin with the tiniest of scar tissue in the very center. It is not even visible without looking very close and inspecting the area. After talking with others, I found that the speed of the entire process was weeks shorter than normal and white, twisted irregular scarring is the rule over the entire area being treated. I have since then highly recommended use of the laser following surgery. Both for appearance of the scar and to minimize adhesions and the resultant complications of most surgeries.

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
